

INDIAN CHILD WELFARE ACT RESOURCE LIST

1. **Indian Child Welfare Act**, 25 U.S.C. Section 1901, *et seq.*
2. **Nebraska Indian Child Welfare Act**, Neb. Rev. Stat. Section 43-1501, *et seq.*

Click on “Browse and/or search the CFR”. Click on “Search or browse your choice of CFR titles and/or volumes”. Scroll down to Title 25 Indians. Click on the most recent date available, currently April 1, 2006. Scroll down to the bottom of the page and click “Continue”. Scroll down the next page. In the column “Browse Parts”, click on “1-299”. Click on Section 23 Indian Child Welfare Act. (23.11 Notice)

4. **Federal Register**: <http://www.gpoaccess.gov/fr/search.html>

Use the most recent volume, and type “Indian Entities Recognized” in the search box. Search the list for “Indian Entities Recognized and Eligible to Receive Services from the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs”. This is the list of federally recognized tribes. The list was not published in some years, so if you cannot find the list in the current year, search the previous year. Most current publication was November 25, 2005 (number 5 in the retrieved results).

5. **Federal Register**: <http://www.gpoaccess.gov/fr/search.html>

Use the most recent volume, and type “Indian Child Welfare Tribal Agents” in the search box. Search the list for Indian Child Welfare Act; Receipt of Designated Tribal Agents . . .” for a list of addresses for tribal agents who receive notice of ICWA proceedings. The list was not published in some years, so if you cannot find the list in the current year, search the previous year. Most current publication was August 2, 2006 (number 8 in retrieved results).
