Psychologist and psychoanalyst, Professor of Pediatrics and Psychiatry at Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center (LSUHSC) in New Orleans.

Dr. Osofsky has received numerous honors and awards for her research, intervention, and clinical work with infants and families at high psychosocial risk. She has studied adolescent mothers as well as infants, children, and families exposed to community and domestic violence and maltreatment.

She is an international consultant for the intervention and treatment of infants and toddlers who have experienced trauma. Since 1997 she has been consulting and collaborating with Judge Cindy Lederman, Administrative Judge of the Juvenile Court in Miami/Dade county related to the development and evaluation of programs to benefit high risk young children and families in court. She is currently helping children and families in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina.

This all-day session will assist Early Childhood providers in the identification and verification of infants and toddlers with social/emotional developmental delay and provide information on effective intervention strategies to support this development.
